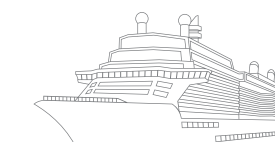

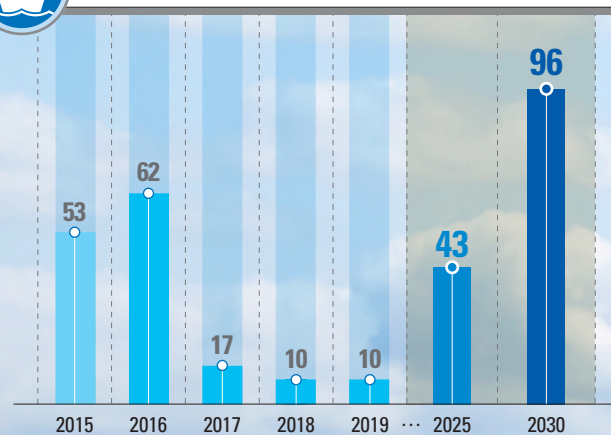

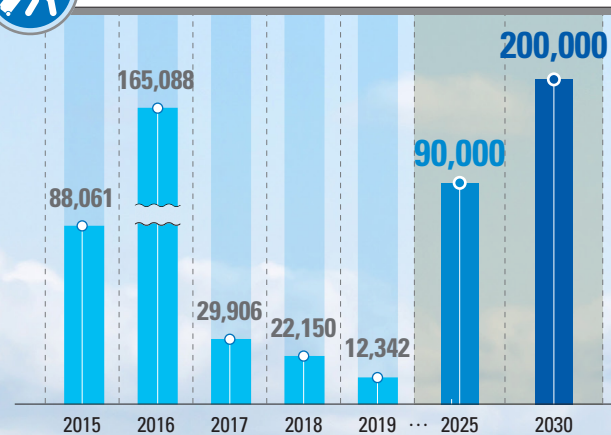
Number of cruises entering Incheon Port (Unit: no. of ships)

Current status of Incheon Port cruise tourists (Unit: people)



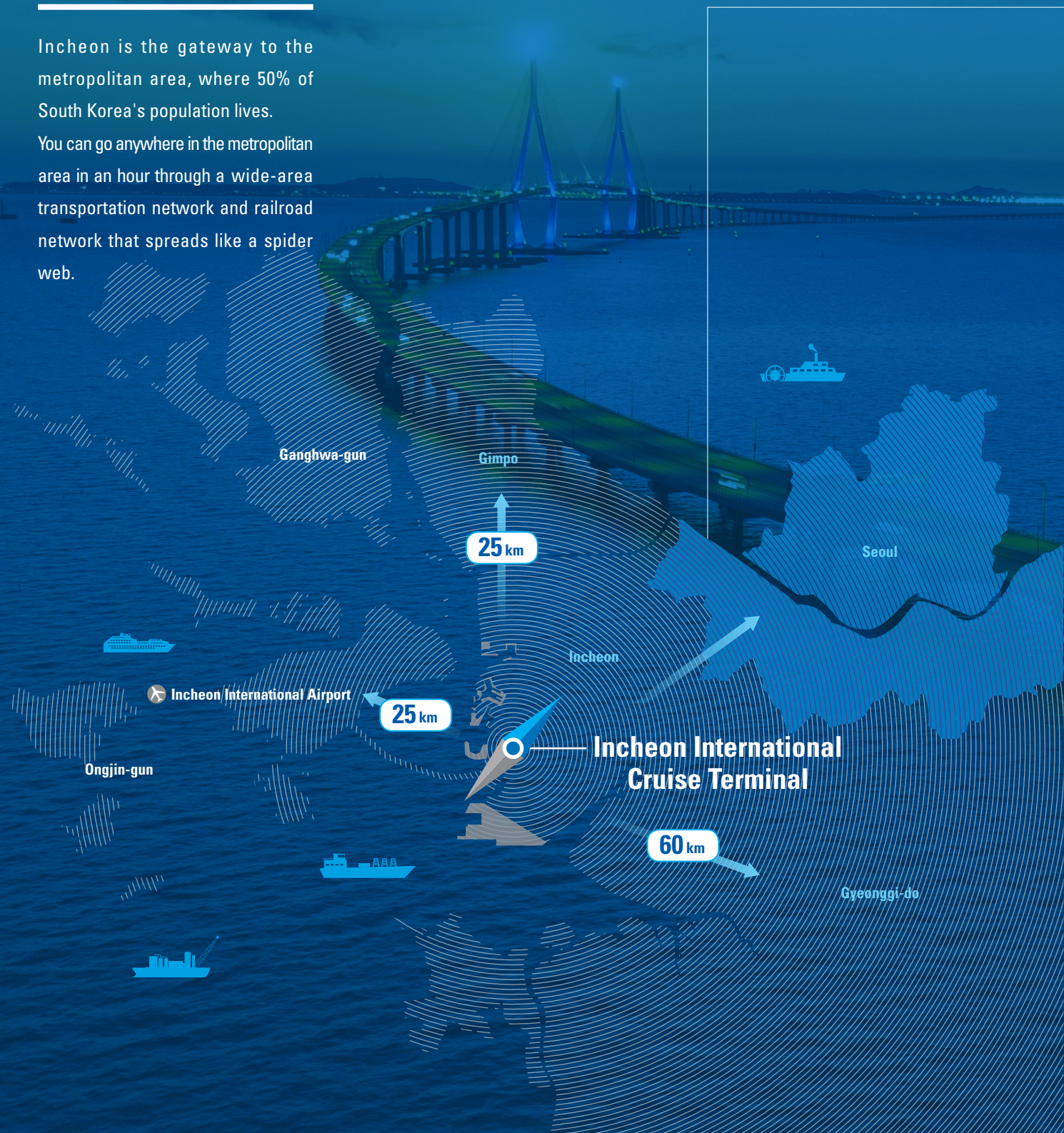

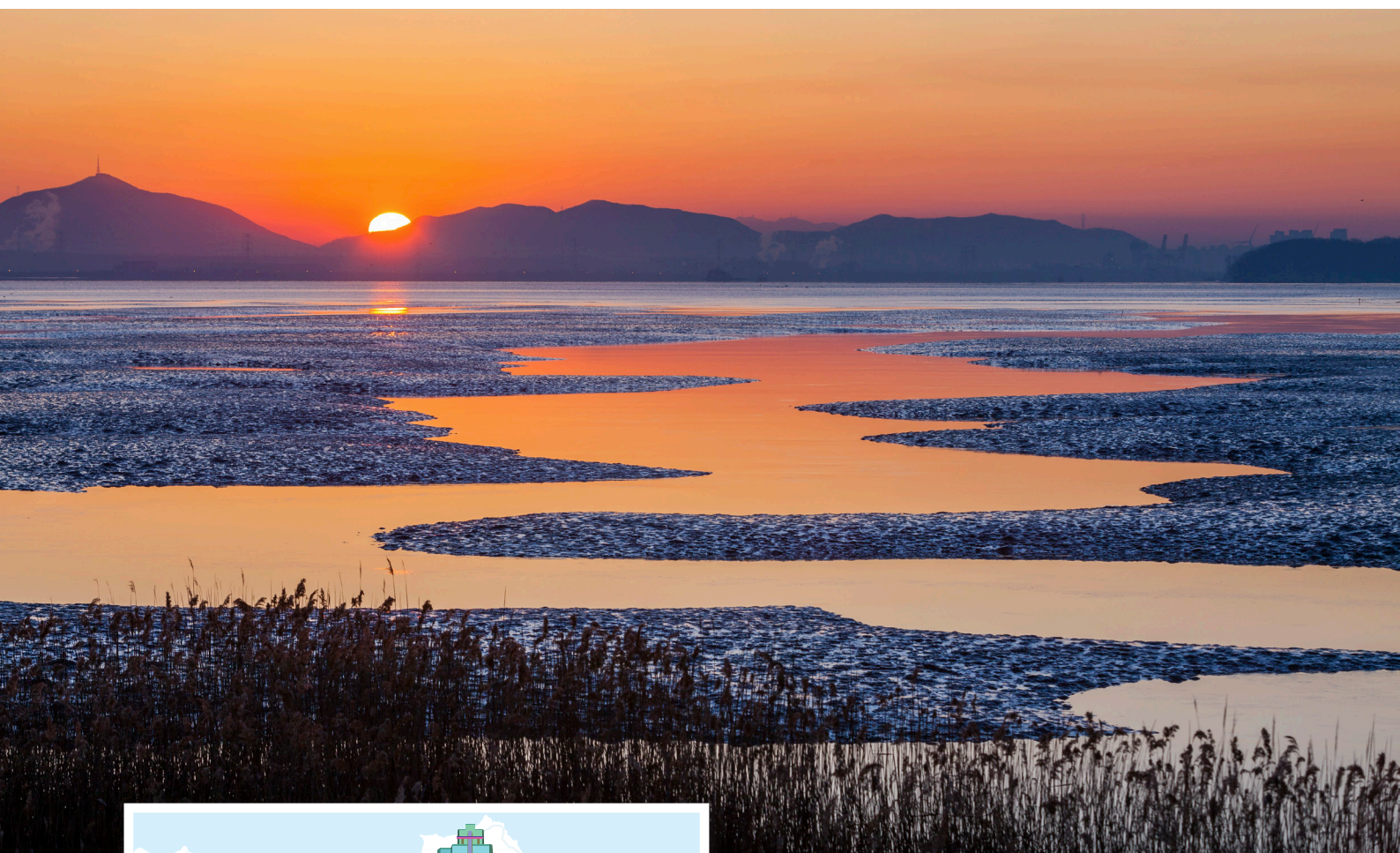

Incheon Jayu Park

Jayu Park is Korea's first modern park built in 1888 for the first time in five years since the opening of Incheon Port. A panoramic view of Incheon Port and Wolmido Island from the top of the park is also an indispensable point.



Open Port Area



Incheon Open Port is the first ports to accept foreign artifacts. Although it has the pain of modern history, it is now positioned as an essential course for tourists who have been newly renovated in various forms such as museums and exhibition halls.

Incheon Art Platform

The area of Haeam-dong, Jung-gu, Incheon is a well-preserved area of buildings built in the 1930s and 1940s, and is recognized for its architectural value. It is used culturally by taking advantage of the historical and spatial characteristics of the city.



China Town



Chinatown, which started in 1883, is a typical tourist destination in Incheon, which is visited by many visitors every year. When Incheon Port opened, Overseas Chinese entered and exited the open port, forming the appearance of Chinatown.

Songwol-dong Donghwa(Fairy Tale) Village

Perfectly transformed the entire village into a fairy tale village to infuse new vitality. Decorated with different themed roads, the place offers a variety of murals, buildings and even themed gourmet food.



Wolmi Culture Street

The wide sea in front of you attracts tourists. It is a city with a theme that harmonizes culture, art, performances, water screen music fountains, etc. on the youthful streets that represent Incheon.

It is a park that reproduces the garden style of the Joseon Dynasty. It is loved as a park with beautiful gardens and buildings. You can also experience various other experience programs.

Songdo Central Park



Songdo Central Park is a huge park in the city center with a total area of 370,750 m2. It is located in the middle of the advanced business district and the residential complex in the international business complex, which is the core area of Songdo International City.

Incheon Urban History Museum

With the theme of Incheon's urban development process, it is a space where you can meet the urban history and transition process of Incheon, which has newly departed as a modern city since the opening of the port in 1883. You can also participate in exhibitions dealing with culture and history and various educational programs.

Bupyeong Underground Shopping Mall

The shopping center "Bupyeong Modu Mall" in Bupyeong-gu, Incheon is located in the basement of Bupyeong Station, and is also called the underground shopping mall of Bupyeong Station. Bupyeong Modu Mall has 1408 stores as of 2016.



Pyeongnidan-gil



If you enter along the alley of Bupyeong Culture Street, which is located between Bupyeong Station and Bupyeong Market Station, you will face the "Pyeongnidangil", which has its own unique cafes and shops.

Guwol-dong Rodeo Street

"Incheon Rodeo Street" is adjacent to the bus terminal and subway station and has excellent accessibility. It is a place centered on various convenience facilities such as restaurants, department stores, and clothing stores, fashion, and consumer culture.



Square One(Shopping Mall)



Located in 926 Dongchun-dong, Yeonsu-gu, Incheon-si, it is in the center of the Korean wave(Hallyu), which leads the world's lifestyle. There are about 170 brands in the store, and you can fully enjoy food and shopping culture.

G-Tower Observatory(IFEZ PR Center)

It is one of the representative landmarks of Songdo, where the secretariats of various international organizations such as the United Nations International Organization Green Climate Fund (GCF) and UN organizations have moved in. You can see at a glance the appearance of Songdo International City, which is developing day by day.

Tri-bowl

The name is a composite word of "triple" which means the sky(airport), the sea (harbor), and the ground(wide area transportation network) and "bowl" which means the vessel. It has the meaning of symbolizing the Incheon Free Economic Zone, which consists of Songdo, Cheongna, and Yeongjong.

Goryeosan Mountain Azalea Festival

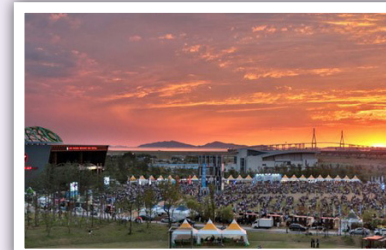

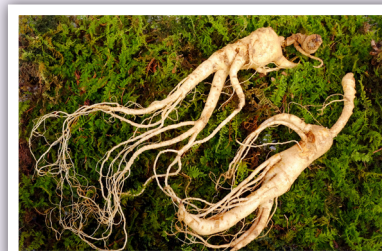

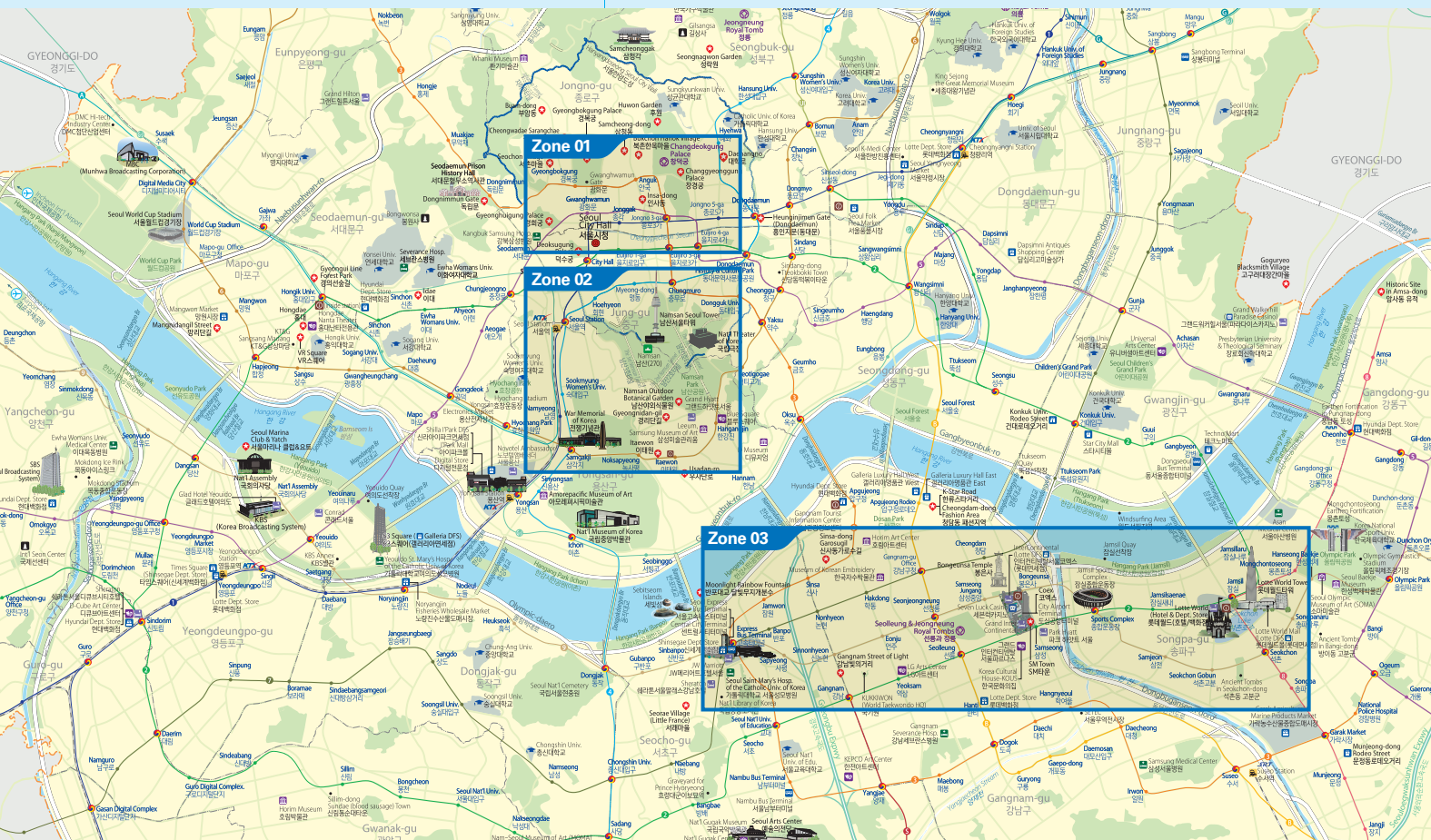

① Gyeongbokgung



The 500-year history of the Joseon Dynasty has just begun at the first palace in the Joseon Dynasty. The largest and most magnificent of the five remaining palaces in Seoul, you can get a glimpse of the magnificent royal culture, life and architectural culture of the time.

② Gwanghwamun Square



In front of the main gate of Gyeongbokgung, a large square with a length of 557m and a width of 34m, there are statues of King Sejong and General Yi Sun-sin, who are the most respected Koreans.

③ Cheonggyecheon



It is a 10.84 km long river that runs from Gwanghwamun to Dongdaemun, and you can enjoy the night view of the Cheonggyecheon River shining under the lights, including 22 bridges on the promenade.

Myeong-dong·Namsan Mountain

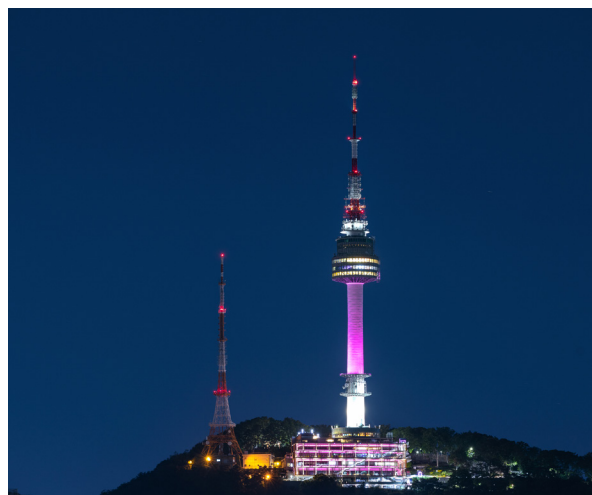

① Myeong-dong street

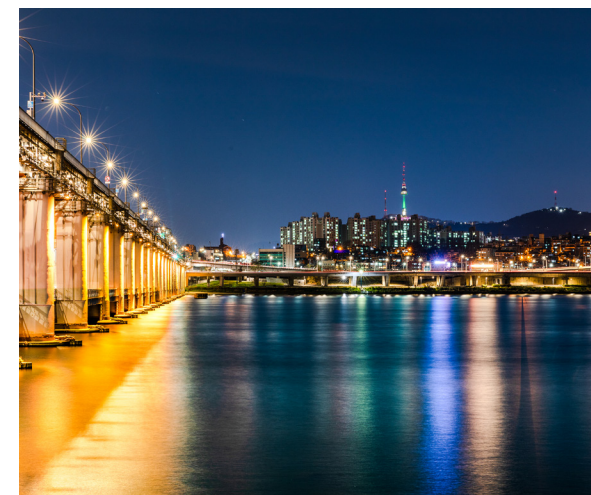

① Lotte World Tower



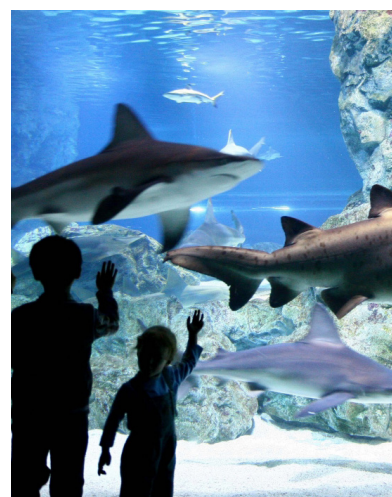
