Traveling in Incheon through All Four Seasons

Spring (March to May) | Flowers and Nature

As the flowers start to bloom in March, numerous visitors also start to appear in the local parks to enjoy them. The Spring Flower Festival is held on Mt. Goryeosan and in Gyeyang Kkotmaru (flower bed). Because daily temperatures vary greatly in the spring — from lows of 5°C to highs of 18°C — visitors are encouraged to play it safe and wear a light coat.
