




Songdo International City

Songdo International City was the first designated special economic zone in the Republic of Korea (South Korea), standing side by side with Singapore, Dubai, and other global-standard international cities. It has been nurtured as a global hub in the high-tech knowledge service industry, hosting a multitude of international organizations, business corporations (both Korean and international), and prestigious universities, all in one place. Another of Songdo's nice characteristics lies in its role as an urban 'lung,' as it has been planned to serve as a venue for human beings and nature to live in harmony. As a result, the city has been chosen as an excellent case of a green city.



Cheongna International City is a business town designed under a new concept where working and living co-exist. Together with Songdo and Yeongjong, Cheongna International City rounds out the three cities that constitute the Incheon Free Economic Zone (IFEZ). Cheongna has been under consistent development as a center for international business and leisure, a key transportation axis linking Yeongjong and Seoul through the Incheon International Airport Expressway, Airport Railroad, Gyeongin Expressway, and Gyeongin Ara Waterway, also standing tall for its excellent location as a coastal city surrounded by the sea.





Hidden Story

One of the ways to truly appreciate touring around Incheon is by taking a city tour on a double-decker bus to cover various tourist sites. There are two circulation lines departing from Central Park in Songdo International City: Ocean Line and Open Port Line. There are also other courses that span various themes, including the Night Tour and tours according to your preference for duration. For those who feel like looking around Cheongna International City, the Eco Tour Line brings you to spots like Jeongseojin, the National Institute of Biological Resources, Canal Way (an artificial canal), and Cheongna Ecological Garden.

INCHEON INTERNATIONAL FERRY TERMINAL

Travels that bring tomorrows Incheon Port International Passenger Terminal

Incheon Port International Passenger Terminal, emerging as a new center for exchanges between Korea and China, has been developed as an international passenger terminal with the goal of maximizing the port's operational efficiency and promoting Incheon Harbor as an internationally renowned beautiful harbor. Starting in December 2016, the construction was carried out over 3.5 years, opening on June 15, 2020. Let's take a look around the new international passenger terminal!

Incheon Port International **Passenger Terminal** spread out over a total floor area of 65,660 m^2 — or roughly the size of nine soccer fields. It is 1.8 times larger than the former International Passenger Terminal 1 and 2 combined. The international passengers wharf and terminal, built with a construction budget of KRW 680 billion, represents the single largest building in the harbor since Incheon opened its port in 1883. The terminal building features five curved roofs to depict the image of waves on the five oceans, adding even more magnificence to the surrounding scenery. The interior was designed with consideration for people with mobility issues and is free of any obstacles. The building also uses a heating/cooling system based on geothermal heat that contributes to higher energy efficiency. The plan is to create shopping malls and a resort nearby, and the terminal is dreaming ahead to its emergence as a marine tourism hub for East Asia.

On the third floor of the International Passenger Terminal, there is a Marine Safety Experience Hall. Here, visitors can gain hands-on marine life-saving experience using actual life-saving equipment. The Marine Safety Experience Hall provides various programs on training to respond to possible safety accidents on the sea. Anyone can take part in training on international code of safety equipment and signage for ships, as set by the International Maritime Organization (IMO), as well as on the use of life-saving equipment, full-mask breathing against drowning accidents, and first aid.


A Unique Landscape amidst the Skyscrapers




Posco Tower - Songdo (Panoramic 65) An Architecture of an Unusual Shape and Pattern

Songdo Convensia

A global-standard convention center

Just as Sydney has its Opera House, Incheon has Songdo Convensia. The three pointy roofs and pleasantly curved top of Songdo Convensia may even evoke hints of the great Opera House in Sydney. However, this design came from the motif of the Taebaek Mountains in Korea. Located at just a 20-minute ride from Incheon International Airport, Songdo Convensia has an exhibition hall, conference hall, and event hall, all with international-standard, cuttingedge ubiquitous facilities. Moreover, it boasts diverse elements of infrastructure for boarding in the close vicinity, with the Sheraton Grand Incheon, Oakwood Premier Incheon, and four other five-star hotels located nearby. For both its beautiful exterior and high-tech facilities, it has constantly garnered favor since its opening on October 7, 2008, also serving as the background to many commercial films.

Tri-Bowl

An artistic space that catches the eye

This eye-catching piece of architecture with its unique feature of a spiraling structure is none other than Tri-Bowl. With its name combining 'Triple' ('three') and 'bowl,' Tri-Bowl signifies the three elements of nature: sky (airport), sea (port) and land (broad transportation network). It also encompasses the three parts of Incheon Free Economic Zone: Songdo, Cheongna, and Yongjong. It is a culture complex that accommodates diverse performances, exhibitions, and educational programs for the enjoyment of all. The waters surrounding Tri-Bowl produce reflections of the night beauties across Songdo and are enough to capture the hearts of onlookers.

A representative landmark of Songdo, G-Tower is the administrative headquarters of the IFEZ, with offices of various international organizations, including UN organizations and the Green Climate Fund. Its unique exterior has been fairly recognized, and awarded the Grand Prize in Architecture by Incheon Metropolitan City in 2013. The Sky Garden on the 29th floor and the observatory on the 33rd floor are open to the public at no charge. Indeed, it would be a loss to miss out on enjoying these, as the view covers the entire landscape from Songdo's Central Park to Incheon Bridge and the Yellow Sea. It is well worth a visit to take in the constantly developing city of Songdo.

Yeongjong Bridge Service Area

Yeongjong Bridge Service Area is an emerging hot spot. This service area is the closest to Incheon and closest to the sea in the metropolitan area. It became famous after a popular comedian introduced the idea of enjoying 'Fish Cake and Citron Tea' here on TV, which garnered great interest. Until 2014, the Yeongjong Bridge Service Area was known as 'Yeongdong Bridge Memorial Hall.' In May 2014, it was renovated into Yeongjong Bridge Service Area. Visitors will find lots of things to view, eat, and do: the metal sculpture (Fortune Bear), which was recorded as the world's largest metal sculpture, the Food Hall with its various restaurants, and Sunset Lounge, where the fantastic twilight over the Yellow Sea can be enjoyed. Before their departure, tourists may consider taking time to stop in for a quick look around on their way to Incheon International Airport.

Incheon is creating a robot complex of about 767,000 m² in Cheongna International City in order to activate the development and distribution of AI robots and foster them as Korea's future growth industry. Though the complete opening of Incheon Robot Land Theme Park is scheduled for 2021, the experience hall on the first floor is already open to the public. Here, visitors may experience diversified robots and virtual reality, along with dancing, coding, driverless vehicles, drones, and educational components.

Songdo Central Park

A gigantic seawater park in the city center

Songdo Central Park is a gigantic park on an area of 370,750 m² at the center of the city. It is located in the midst of Songdo International City's core zones and the international business complex. Songdo Central Park was formed using cutting-edge engineering technology to prevent the urban heat island phenomenon and to effectively manage recycled rainwater. More than anything, visitors to the park are fascinated by its exotic atmosphere. As Korea's first man-made seawater park, Songdo Central Park boasts the 3.6 km-long seawater stream, water taxis, canoes, and other water-leisure facilities to grab visitors attention and hearts.

Along this 18 km waterway, there are well-developed walking paths and bike trails, as well as an observatory, waterfall, and other elements to observe and admire. A taste of the soul, sentiment, and culture of the Korean nation flows along the sea roads that link the Yellow Sea and the Han River, and Gyeongin Ara Waterway contains the wishes for a 'Global Masterpiece Waterway' fueling a new era of culture for South Korea.

A twilight-dyed world

Often contrasted with Jeongdongjin in Gangneung as its eastern counterpart, Jeongseojin marks the end of due west from Gwanghwamun Gate. There are the symbolic landmarks and sculptures of the Sunset Bell and Sunset Wall. A popular tour program allows visitors to enjoy the setting sun with the theme of 'Romanticism and Nostalgia' in comparison to the sunrise tour of Jeongdongjin marking 'a new start.' There are wooddeck trekking paths along the waterway and a wind power plant in full operation nearby to present quite an exotic atmosphere.
